  - b) A short description of your thesis project, including the current status of the project, timeline and an expected finishing date (max. 2 pages).
  - c) A scanned copy of your current certificate of matriculation\* (student ID card, *Stammdatenblatt*) as a doctoral student at Heidelberg University or a copy of a current employment contract\*\* with Heidelberg University.
  - d) A scanned copy of the most recent university degree
- » Please ask your supervisor to submit an informative letter of recommendation (max. 1 page) directly to the Graduate Academy by email (graduateacademy@uni-heidelberg.de).

## APPLICATION DEADLINE: MARCH 3RD 2009 / PLANNED FUNDING BEGIN: APRIL 2009

- \* Students of the Faculty of Medicine who are pursuing their doctorate during their undergraduate studies (Staatsexamen) are not eligible to apply for a dissertation grant through the Graduate Academy.
- \*\* Employees of external research institutions (for example, DKFZ or MPG) who are not matriculated at Heidelberg University are not eligible to apply for a dissertation grant.
