WHAT WE DO

The Doctoral Convention is the **main representative** of the doctoral candidate body at Heidelberg University, which consists of more than 7000 people. We work closely together with the **university senate**, the **faculty councils**, the **graduate academy**, and other university committees. Our goal is to **improve the working conditions and the daily life** of all doctoral candidates, independent from their field of research or type of employment.

The Convention is financed by **semester contributions** of enrolled doctoral candidates. We mainly use this money for **funding projects** targeted at doctoral candidates. Additionally, we foster the Convention as a networking forum by hosting **social events**. New ideas on how to spend our funds in everyone's best interest are always welcome: If you require **financial support** for seminars and workshops you organize or an event you host, contact us!

OUR STRUCTURE

The **Executive Committee** constitutes the head of the Convention, and is elected for one year. Every doctoral candidate registered at Heidelberg University has the right to vote this committee in the annual **General Assembly**. The Convention forms **Working Groups**, in which people can participate informally to tackle specific issues. We report our advances at **Open Regular Meetings**, where we would also like to hear **your ideas, suggestions and feedback** on our work.
