## Information regarding the Application for Child Benefits

### **General information**

The child benefit is a monthly payment of **400 Euro** for one child. For each additional child the child benefit is increased by **100 Euro per month**, respectively.

You are eligible to receive a child benefit under the following conditions:

- a) if you have or your spouse has been granted child allowance payments for a common child under the Income Tax Act or the Federal Child Allowance Act,
- b) if you, as a single parent, receive child allowance payments for a child under the Income Tax Act or the Federal Child Allowance Act,
- c) if, due to your non-German citizenship, you have no legal claim to child allowance payments under the Income Tax Act or the Federal Child Allowance Act but can prove with a certificate from the local residents' office (*Einwohnermeldeamt*) that your child(ren) live in your household.

If a claim to child benefits arises during the bridging grant period, the benefits will be granted beginning with the child's month of birth.
